79. Grants Awarded by SNH during the year to 31 March 2004

Every year we sample over one hundred of the grants awarded three or more years previously in order to determine whether or not they comply with the conditions of grant. This provides us with valuable insights into ways in which we can further improve our grants system. In 2003/04, the major non-compliance (failure) rate was only 0.8% of the sample and this case is being resolved with the recipient.
