## 85. Grants Awarded by SNH during the year to 31 March 2005

Every year contractors undertake a compliance monitoring exercise on our behalf, which entails a check on over one hundred grants awarded three years previously. This provides us with valuable insights into ways we can further improve our grants system. In 2004/05, the major non-compliance (failure) rate for 2001/02 grants was only 0.66% of the sample. Problems with the case involved are being resolved with the recipient.

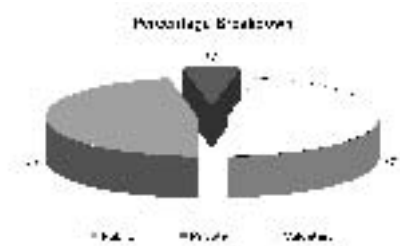

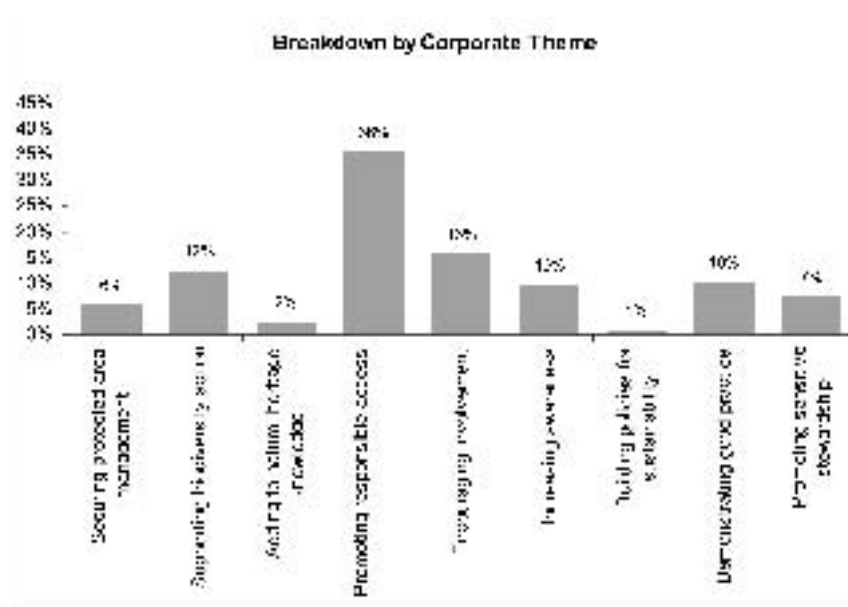
